

# British Values at Great Denham Primary

At Great Denham we are committed to serving our community and surrounding areas. We recognise the multicultural, multi-faith nature of the United Kingdom and understand the crucial role our school plays in promoting these values. We are a school for all. This statement outlines the key British values we actively promote.

## Democracy

- Children are involved in democratic processes e.g. voting for school, councillors and shared rewards.
- The school council is led by a member of staff who adheres to the democratic process.
- We have links to the local PCSOs who come into school to educate the children about upholding British Law.

## Mutual Respect

- Our PSHE curriculum embodies values of mutual respect through the teaching about relationships and being a responsible citizen.
- Respect is embedded within our whole school as it is one of our key values.
- We also teach equality as one of our core values.
- Children are consulted on many aspects of school life e.g. Choosing play equipment.

## Individual Liberty

- Children have key roles and responsibilities within the school, such as children in Key Stage 2 who hold roles such as family leaders, head boy / girl, lunchtime helpers.
- Within school, children are actively encouraged to make choices, knowing that they are in a safe and supportive environment. As a school we educate and provide boundaries for children to make choices safely.
- Our curriculum places a significant emphasis on independent learning and choice and freedom about where children work, how they present their work etc. Children take responsibility for their learning and are able to make good choices.
- Through our curricular clubs and opportunities, children are given the freedom to make choices.
