## Keeping Safe - Top tips for parents!

Recently, we have had a number of issues with adverts on YouTube, some of which are unsuitable for our pupils to see. Unfortunately, there is currently no way of blocking these adverts



or controlling them. Whilst YouTube is set to restricted mode in school and our internet filters will pick up and block most inappropriate matter, adverts are incredibly difficult to manage. As a result, we have had to block the use of YouTube for the children's iPads whilst they are in school. We are looking into a way of managing this in the longer term, but until this is resolved we need to ensure the children are safe.

We have also put measures into place to ensure that if YouTube is used in lessons ads are not seen by pupils and are hoping for a long term solution to this as well. We will continue to educate the children on the safe use of YouTube and other applications so that they have the tools to keep themselves safe and know what to do if something worries them.

We also want you to be aware of the problem with pop up ads in YouTube at home and the following link provides information on how you can ensure you have the best parental controls set up on any devices your children may use at home.




