

# YEAR 3 & 4 UPDATE

Year 3 and 4 have returned back to school and have jumped straight into our new project of Robin Hood and forests with such a positive attitude. On Monday, we discovered a fire on the school grounds with some lanterns and a treasure chest, which revealed some chapters of a book and a map! After this we began to think someone was lost or here for safety.

The map, which had an "X marks the spot", led us on a journey to Rushmere Country Park. This was such an exciting experience for the children as they were amazed by what a rich woodland had to offer. We saw squirrels scurrying up the trees, fairy doors dotted around the base of the tall trees, bark covered pathways and steep hills which led deeper into the woods. After a short walk, we set up camp in the woods and began den building, bark rubbing, resource collecting and listening to the sounds in the forest. Whilst we were there we discovered the remains of an arrow - this must be what the "X" was for!

The children are now working on discovering who lives in a forest, what is the difference between a forest and a wood and beginning to learn the legend of Robin Hood.
