Thank you for the positive comments and suggestions to improve our remote learning offer. We have reviewed them all and are able to take on board some of the suggestions made, please see below.

Changes we have made...

- From next week we will not be having any zoom calls over the lunchtime period between 12–1.30pm
- Library opening times will stay the same each week 2 afternoons and one morning
- Staff will try to give as much notice as possible when planning activities that involve art or cookery
- Daily welcome video for each class explaining the days learning and activities
- Daily live lessons for years 4 6 in English, and Maths for Year 6, rolling out daily Maths lessons too after half term for year 4 and 5 as well
- Trying to find opportunities for siblings to work together on something similar so far the valentines cake bake, and the screen free time sessions starting next week
- Having work packs available before 1pm on a Monday from week commencing 8th February we will have these ready for 10am on Monday
- Including Spanish sessions in Key stage 2
- Live lessons for years 4 6 in classes rather than year groups we have started this and are moving to this currently over the next week

These are just a few of the suggestions we have already taken on board. We are still reviewing others that are not so simple and easy to implement so please don't think we are not listening to your feedback and taking it on board, we are constantly refining and trying to improve our offer.
