Admissions criteria for critical workers

The governors have met and reviewed the DfE guidance and our school risk assessment and we have made the decision that at the current time we are able to continue to offer the current places after half term to the children who currently have a place. There is no need for parents to reapply for places.

However, if there is a future surge in demand for places prior to the full re-opening of schools the governors have decided that we will apply an admissions criteria for the allocation of places. Taking into account the DfE guidance and having evaluated our risk assessment in order to keep everyone safe we believe that using an admissions criteria will be the fairest and safest way of allocating places.
